

Harmony of the Spheres Talk by Hartmut Warm

'The Signature of the Celestial Spheres'. As an exposition of a meaningful universe. The results of his work are represented with the aid of computer projections that provide a remarkable experience not only for astronomers but for anyone interested. Ancient ideas of a 'harmony of the spheres' thus reappear in a new light.
